Children's curiosity and imagination naturally evoke learning when unfettered. Davy states that the British Children's Act of 1989 links to play-work as the act works with play workers and sets the standards for the setting such as security, quality and staff ratios.[18] Learning through play has been seen regularly in practice as the most versatile way a child can learn.
