A good network design should therefore seek to optimize both spatial and temporal coverage within the constraints of available resources. The previous section focused on maximizing spatial coverage and the representativity of measurement. Fixed monitoring stations poorly describe exposure for a short time period. However, per-sonal exposure is better related to ambient levels when 8-hour or longer time averages are used. Emission data and the location of the most important sources give valuable information on the hot spots for the siting of monitors.
