This study quantifies the relationship between ambient surface temperatures and EGU air emissions (CO₂, SO₂, and NO_x) using historical data. We find that deploying distributed PV in the east with inter-provincial transmission maximizes potential CO₂ reductions and air quality-related health benefits (4.2% and 1.2% decrease in national total CO₂ emissions and air pollution-related premature deaths compared to the base case, respectively).
