Workers compensation systems are established by statutes in each state. State laws and court decisions control the program in that state and no two states have exactly the same laws and regulations. States determine such features as the amount of benefits to which an employee is entitled, what impairments and injuries are covered, how impairments are to be evaluated and how medical care is to be delivered. For example, the leading cause of workers comp death claims is traffic accidents that occur when the employee is in a vehicle for work purposes, whether the trip is made in the company's car or the employee's own vehicle. Accidents driving to and from work are not covered.

States have enacted workers compensation laws to replace traditional personal injury litigation, in an attempt to remove risk for both the employee and the employer. Outside of a workers' compensation system, employees who become injured or sick as a result of their employment must file a lawsuit and prove their employer is responsible. This can result in delays, and there is a possibility the employee will lose the court case and recover nothing. By federal law, American employees enjoy legal protections that“ among other things“ provide a minimal level of income and make the workplace safer. However, a push for employee rights gained momentum in the 20th century, resulting in a series of important laws that millions of Americans rely on to this day. These days, the Department of Labor enforces roughly 180 worker protection laws, ranging from pay requirements to parental leave benefits. Other protections are supervised by agencies such as the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission. Following, we explore eight key federal protections afforded employees. 1. The Minimum Wage. The Fair Labor Standards Act ensures that American workers receive a minimum wage for their work. 2. The law protects disabled persons by making it unlawful to discriminate against such persons in the interviewing and hiring process and regarding the terms of the offer of employment. Employers are required to make reasonable adjustments in the place of work to accommodate disabled persons. However, cost may be taken into account when determining what is reasonable. 5. Employment law can be found in a number of different sources. The main sources are the common law, legislation and European law. Other sources include codes of practice and regulations, journal articles, the Internet and employment encyclopedias can also be an invaluable source of information.
