Birney's Humphrey, Stephanie Greene's Princess Posey, First Grader, and Victoria Coe's Fenway and Hattie. Since joining Penguin Random House in 2010, Arianne has acquired and edited the work of the Geisel Award-winning picture book author/illustrator Ethan Long; middle-grade and young adult fiction from New York Times bestselling author Rachel Hawkins; and Rick Yancey's #1 New York Times and USA Today bestselling 5th Wave series.
