The MATLAB function `fft` computes, using  $N$  values of the function  $f$  on the interval  $[0, 2\pi)$  (where the values are computed on  $N$  equally spaced points),  $N$  Fourier coefficients up to a factor  $1/N$ . Conversely, the function `ifft` computes from  $N$  Fourier coefficients (correctly ordered) the values of the function in  $N$  equally spaced points in  $[0, 2\pi)$  up to a factor  $N$ . We will explain how this works. We approximate the integral in (1) with a sum. Conversely, if the values of  $F_k$  are given and we want to approximate  $f$  in the points  $2\pi \cdot 2, \dots, 2\pi \cdot (N - 1)$ , then we can use as an approximation of formula (2) (for  $N > 0, N \neq 2\pi \cdot N$  even)  $N \sum_{k=0}^{N-1} F_k \exp(ik \cdot 2\pi \cdot n) = \hat{f}(n)$ . From (3) and the periodicity of the exponential function ( $e^{2\pi i n} = 1$  for integers  $n$ ) it follows that  $\hat{f}(N \cdot k) = \hat{f}(k)$ .
