
Availability of Open Access Books in DOAB for Education Subject: A Study

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Abstract

This paper discussed about the Directory of Open Access Books (DOAB) and their collections. The Directory of Open Access Books provides a searchable index to peer-reviewed monographs and edited volumes published under an Open Access business model, with links to the full texts of the publications at the publisher's website or repository. Further it concentrate the books available for the education subject. Based on the available data the total 106 books available as on 14.09.2015. Before 2006 few books are available in the open access. In this directory 91 books are single author contribution.

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INTRODUCTION

The present world is controlled by the Information Technology. Due to the revolutionary changes in the field of IT, the whole world is turned into a global village. The primary aim of DOAB is to increase discoverability of Open Access books. Academic publishers are invited to provide metadata of their Open Access books to DOAB. Metadata will be harvestable in order to maximize dissemination, visibility and impact. Aggregators can integrate the records in their commercial services and libraries can integrate the directory into their online catalogues, helping scholars and students to discover the books. The directory is open to all publishers who publish academic, peer reviewed books in Open Access and

should contain as many books as possible, provided that these publications are in Open Access and meet academic standards.

REVIEW OF LITERATURE

Lone, Rather & Shah (2008) revealed that India is continuously contributing in OA literature as some of the premier institutions, particularly in the S&T area which are providing open access to their research publications and revealed that India is at the 7th position in the DOAJ and is sharing 10th position with Sweden and Spain in Directory of Open Access Repositories (Open DOAR) in terms of number of repositories in the world. Mohamed (2009) Open source movement plays a vital role in the development of open education resources in higher education. Open source e-learning courseware (OSeLCW) is an initiative within this movement. Many institutions today post their courses for free and open access via the Internet to users all over the world. This paper assesses the awareness, access, and utilisation of such wealth of web-based OSeLCW among educators and students of engineering colleges in Mysore city. Archana and Subhash (2009) analysed 114 open access journals in the area of Computer Science, also described based on their periodicity, publication year, subject-wise distribution and place of publication. Open Access Journals maintain the traditional values of journals-notably peer review, but also editing and formatting and marketing. Choudhary (2010) analyzed 114 OA

journals in Computer Science included in DOAJ. They concluded that 21 % of the journals are published from USA while only two journals are published from India, and English is the most popular language of the OA Journals in Computer Science.

Ajay Kumar (2011) stated in his paper that internet promoted the revolutionary movement to free access to scholarly journals. He has also highlights some of the Open Access Journals initiatives in India especially in the field of geography. This paper enlists all the Geography journals on the DOAJ and their analysis based on different criteria

out of 106 6 books does not have the licenses. It is pointed out that the table, 40books got the CC-BY-NC-ND licenses which is in the first position.
