Information systems are scalable platforms that provide management with control over data to facilitate top level strategizing and decision making. For example, an organization may use customer relationship management systems to gain a better understanding of its target audience, acquire new customers and retain existing clients. Systems Approach to management views the organization as several components, or systems and each system executes its functions as an independent unit. This systems approach looks upon the management as a "System" of as an organized whole make up of sub-systems integrated into a unity or orderly totality. The attention should be given so overall effectiveness of the system rather than effectiveness of any sub-system if isolation. It is based on system analysis. It attempts to identify the nature of relationships of various parts of the system.
