Ideally, your school should have a plan for evaluating not only large, complex programs, but also smaller and simpler strategies and practices.

1. Define Terms. The first step is defining terms. Schedule the evaluation in advance and measure at the right time to "catch" good effects. If possible, conduct one or more "baseline" (pretest) measurements as well as several posttest measurements spaced over time. Be feasible (someone has the time to collect necessary data on an ongoing basis; school data team is in place to help plan and analyze). Measure at multiple levels (individual, small-group, class, grade and population/school levels). Measure at the group level to evaluate efforts that reach smaller groups; measure at the population level to evaluate efforts that reach the entire school.

6: Evaluating teaching. Just as assessment that supports learning is critical for student development, teacher evaluation that focuses on providing accurate evidence of practice and supports improvement is central for teachers' development. Having clear standards that teachers are expected to meet is an important starting point considered in this chapter.

Educators, policy makers, parents, and others interested in improving the way we measure learning in today's schools need to examine three essential questions: 1) What really matters in a contemporary education? 2) How should we assess those things that matter? 3) How might our assessments enhance learning that matters, not just measure it? What Matters in a Contemporary Education? Which leads us to our third big question: How might assessments become more integral to learning, as opposed to just evaluating it? To say that assessment should serve learning is a nice slogan, but what exactly does it mean? Over the years, Wiggins and I conducted a workshop exercise to explore this question.
