Covering some of the same ground as did James Coates in *Armed and Dangerous* (1987), this is a book by two authors whose collaboration began when the Rocky Mountain News assigned them to the Alan Berg assassination. Berg was the first name on the hit list of The Order, or The Silent Brotherhood, a cadre of racists recruited from such groups as Aryan Nations and the Klan, and held together by the powerful personality of Robert Jay Matthews. The book begins as a biography of Matthews, following his path to radical racism: surprisingly, the authors generate some empathy.
