This module will examine the "state of welfare" from the Second World War to the present. It will ask why the British state became a "Welfare State" after the war and examine the subsequent development and changes in welfare policies. It will examine social conditions through the period: poverty, wealth and income distribution, health and health care, life expectancy, employment and unemployment, childhood and ageing, disability, single parenthood, housing conditions, education and development and change in policies related to all of these topics. It will study the political, social and economic contexts in which the Welfare State expanded and then contracted including the roles of political parties, campaigning groups and interest groups.
