For beginning and advanced students alike, the guide offers practical advice for doing research and writing critical papers on Shakespeare—including how to select and develop topics, prepare a working bibliography and outline, take notes, avoid plagiarism, and use appropriate documentation following the MLA system. Bergeron, professor of English at the University of Kansas, is the author of *Shakespeare's Romances and the Royal Family and Pageantry in the Shakespearean Theater* and the editor of *Reading and Writing in Shakespeare*. Shakespeare-focused educational approaches to tackling offending behaviours have been deemed appropriate to operate in multiple US states for over two decades.
